

The State Government of Michoacan through the Secretary of the Migrants Office in compliance with the agreement by which the "Binational Nursing" program was created, and its operating rules published in the official journal of the constitutional government of the state of Michoacan, on June 19th., 2015 announces a selection procedure for the aforementioned program.

CALL FOR PARTICIPATION

To all the nursing graduates from public or private institutions, who are domiciled in the State of Michoacán, are welcomed to participate in the selection procedure for the "Binational Nursing" program.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

The Nursing Binational program aims to provide administrative and economic support to graduates from nursing institutions in the state of Michoacan to be trained for the certification process that is offered by the Department of Nursing and Health Sciences in the United States of America.

- 1. This is a program oriented to graduate nurses and sponsored by the local Government. This program is subject to budget.
- 2. Participants must follow the procedure hereunder:
 - a) Fill out a registration form and complete a socio-economic fact sheet (this is available at the Secretary of Migrants Office)
 - b) Attend an interview to the Department of Binational Affairs Office, at Secretary of Migrants Office in Morelia, Michoacán on a requested date.
- 3. For those applicants who successfully completed phase one and two must turn-in the requested documents
 - a) Nursing Degree, original and a notarized copy;
 - b) Professional License, original and a notarized copy;
 - c) Certificate of English language proficiency;
 - d) Signed verification of employment letter (Health Institutions) of former or current employee;
 - e) Résumé;
 - f) Participants must be a minimum of 22 and a maximum of 50 years of age;
 - g) Birth certificate (original);
 - h) Criminal Record Clearance;
 - i) Certificate of residence (dispensed by your local municipal authority)
 - j) Original and a copy, of any valid official ID with photograph (INE, Passport);
 - k) Proof of address (water, electricity or telephone bill). All documents presented must be dated within four months of application;
 - I) Employment letter (Health Institutions)
 - m) Personal Statement letter

- 4. Incomplete proposals, with false information or those which were submitted after the deadline will be forfeited.
- 5. Names of pre-accepted applicants will be published on the website of the Secretary of Migrants Office: www.migrante.michoacan.gob.mx.
- 6. Final selection of the candidates will be reviewed by a committee; final decision will be based on the following criteria:
 - Academic grades (8.0 above or its equivalent);
 - Level of English (TOEFL of 540 points in written examination; 207 points CBT;
 - 4.0 points in TWE (Test of Written English) and 50 points on TSE (Test of spoken English).
 - a) Nursing graduates from local Higher Education Institutions
 - b) Experience in the area of health.
- 7. Grants will be assigned according to the financial situations of each of the candidates.
- 8. If any inquiries, please contact the local office of the Secretary of Migrants or the Department of Binational Affairs Office. For matter not explicitly mentioned in the present call, current laws should apply.
